Celebratory Tour Highlights Countywide Collaboration

Mercer County, IL – September 25th, 2019 – Over the past year, Mercer County Better Together (MCBT) led a collaborative effort to upgrade parks and recreation facilities across Mercer County. MCBT worked with communities to identify project needs, then secured funding to accomplish these projects. Through a partnership with the Looser-Flake Foundation, eleven projects across nine communities have come to fruition.



"During our planning process, people across the county shared with us a passion for their parks and recreation facilities," said MCBT Executive Director Kyle McEwen. "Residents feel a sense of ownership in these spaces and consider them the heart of 'community'. We're thrilled to play a role in making these projects happen. It's amazing what we can accomplish when we join together."

Leaders from all Mercer County communities were invited to participate in the collaboration, which saw stakeholders insist on sharing resources to make sure all projects were successful. The eleven participating entities brought over 72% in match value and received a total of \$150,000 to help accomplish projects.

Many participants found ways to share costs or resources.

Trustees of the Looser-Flake Foundation offered their appreciation for the collaboration. "I really enjoyed seeing the projects and meeting the people who were involved," said trustee Frank Mitvalsky.

Trustee Peter Benson added, "You're the ones doing the hard work. We're lucky to have the role of supporting your work in building on these great community resources."
